**PROCESS**

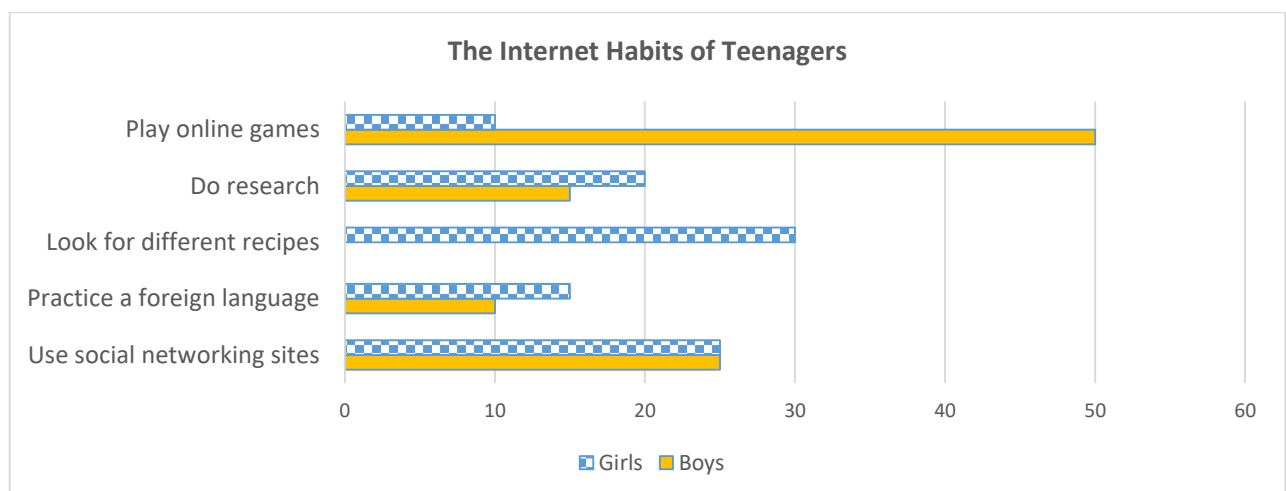
- Heat oven to 205 degrees °C. Spread some oil into the muffin cups.

- Bake for 15 to 20 minutes. Cool 1 minute before removing from cups.
