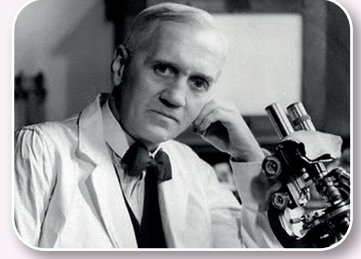




Answer the questions (1-2) according to the passage.

It was one of the most important discoveries of the century. He won the Nobel Prize for Medicine in 1945. Fleming died because of a heart attack on March 11, 1955.

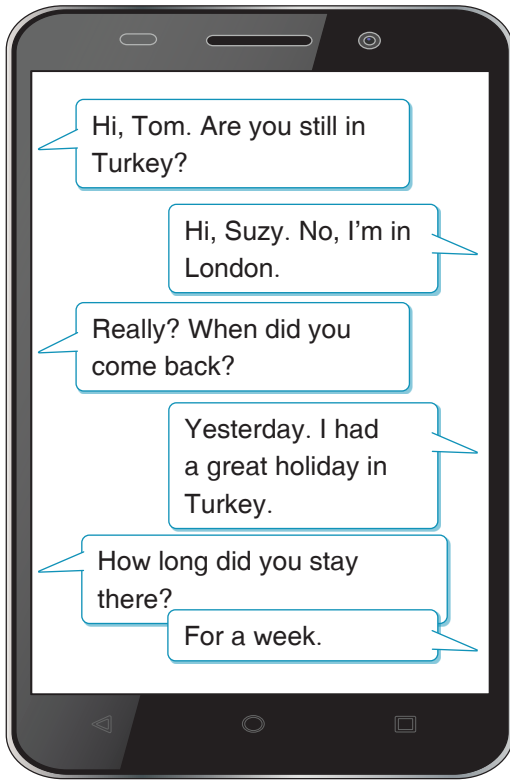
