- d. Tom's grandmother spent most of her time indoors when she was a child.

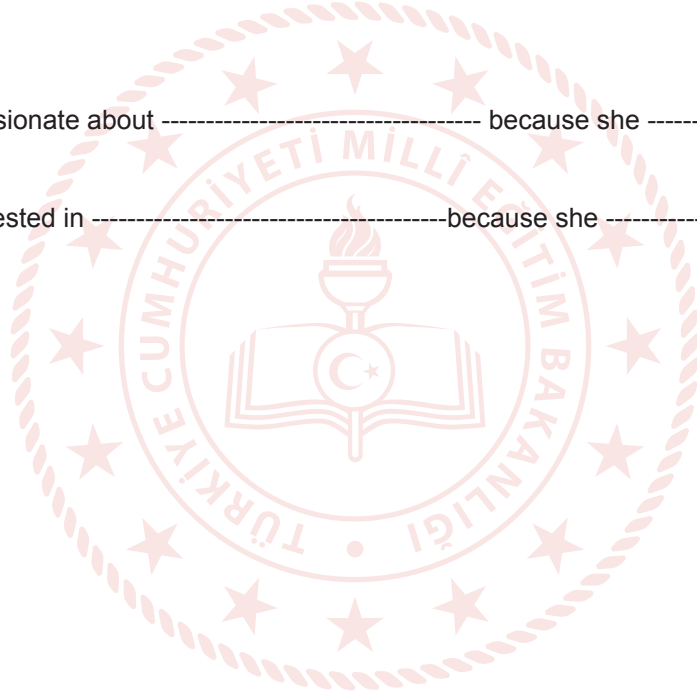

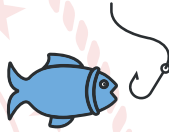




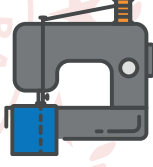
