


Learning Outcome: E11.3.R1. Students will be able to answer the questions about a text on people's habits and experiences in the past.

Ali Kuşçu authored two significant books: Fethiye, which focuses on astronomy and Muhammediye, a mathematics book.
Ali Kuşçu passed away in İstanbul in 1474.
Ali Kuşçu was a famous astronomer, mathematician, and physicist, and he made significant contributions to astronomy.
Ali Kuşçu was born in Samarkand in 1403.
Ali Kuşçu learned mathematics and astronomy from important scholars of his time, including Kadızâde-i Rûmî, Gıyâsüddin Cemşid el-Kâşî, and Uluğ Bey.
